••• GUIDE & SUPPLYING ARTWORK TIPS •••



Make sure you allow for the 'bleed' in your design, this area must be filled with background colours &/or images.

Ensure all integral parts of your design are kept within the safe area (dotted lines) (See below diagram).

Where possible designs featuring graphics or text should be submitted as vector based PDFs.

To keep your text in vector format, outline fonts in applications such as Adobe Illustrator.
(Shortcut - Ctrl+Shift+O (Windows) or Command+Shift+O (Mac).

THE HIGHER THE IMAGE DPI

THE BETTER THE PRINT!

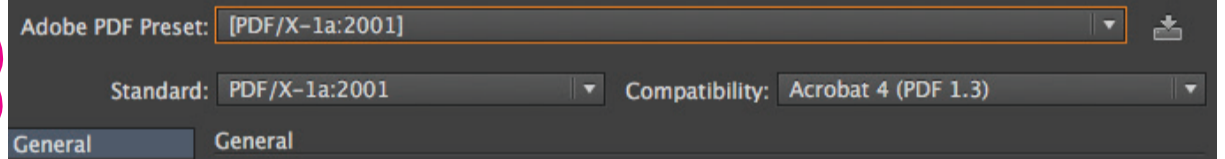
If your design features a mix of photography and text, make sure your images are at least 300 dpi.

Where possible please save your final design as a print ready PDF.

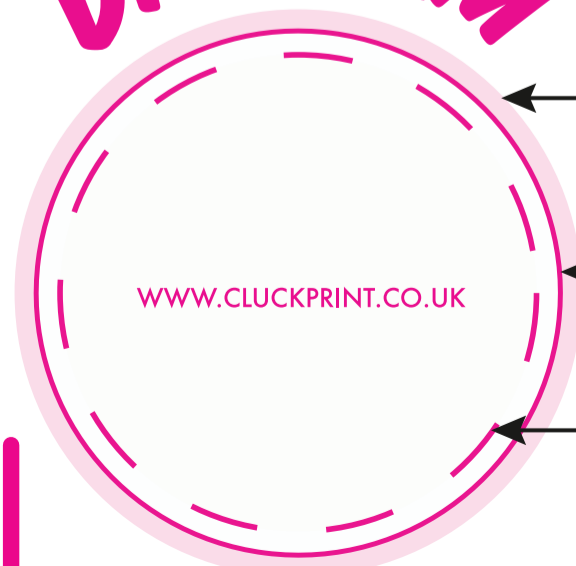
Ensure all fonts are outlined & images are embedded.

Make sure your pre-flight PDFs using the 'Adobe PDF/X-1 a:2001' preset.

TRIM

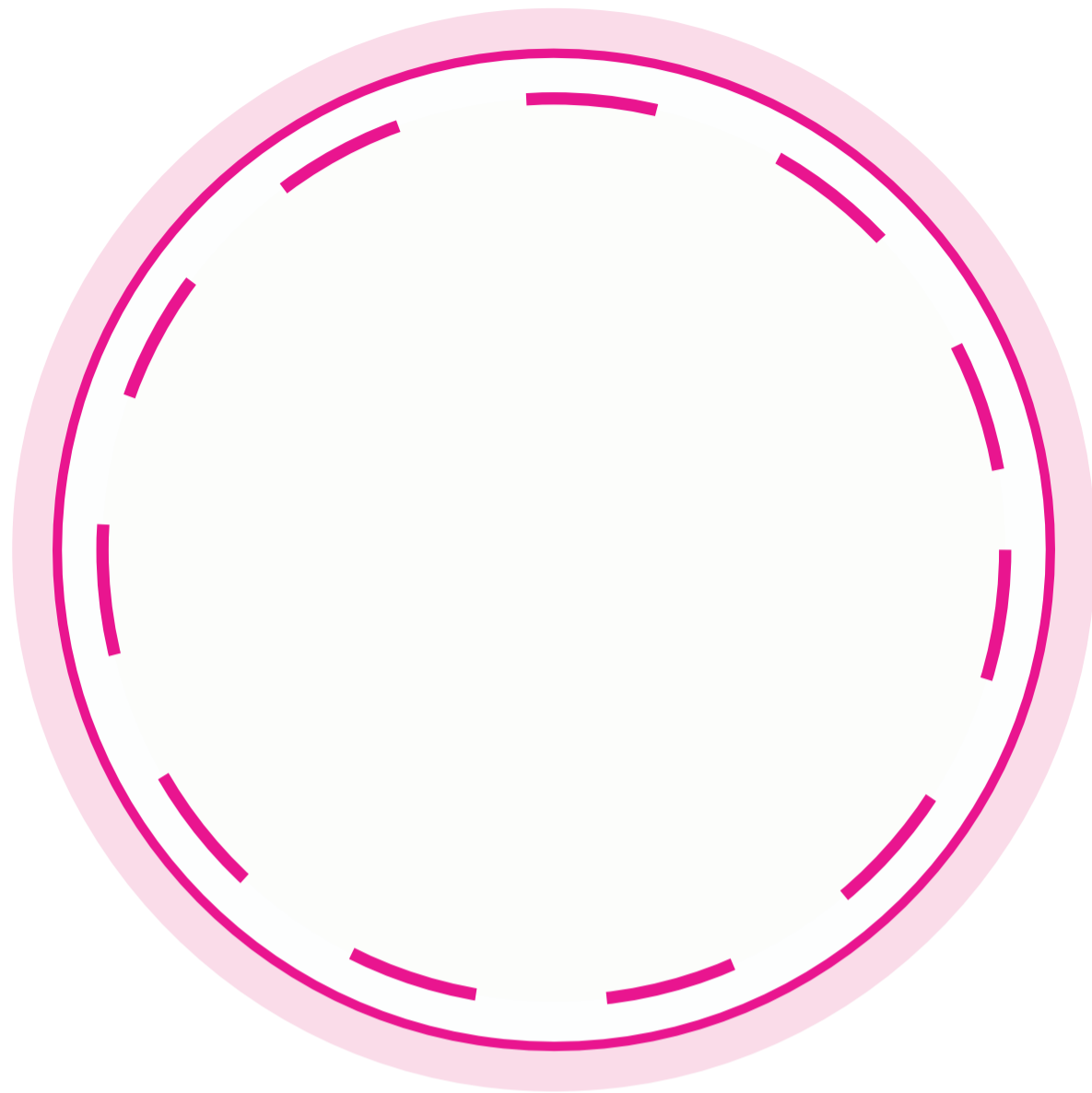
(Where the sticker will be cut to)
